ITINERARY:

Day 1: Arrival at Guwahati – Shillong (98 Km / Approx. 3 Hrs)

Upon arrival at Guwahati Airport/Railway Station, meet and greet with the driver and proceed for darshan at the sacred **Kamakhya Temple**, one of the most revered Shakti Peethas in India, situated atop Nilachal Hill. After darshan, continue your scenic drive towards Shillong, the charming capital of Meghalaya also known as the “Scotland of the East.” En route, enjoy a beautiful photo stop at the picturesque **Umiam Lake**, surrounded by lush green hills. Upon arrival in Shillong, check in to the hotel and relax for the evening.

Overnight stay at Shillong (D)

Day 2: Shillong – Cherrapunjee – Shillong (53 Km / Approx. 2 Hrs One Way)

After breakfast, proceed for a full-day excursion to **Cherrapunjee**, famous for its breathtaking waterfalls, caves, and misty landscapes. En route, visit the beautiful **Elephant Falls** followed by **Duwan Sing Syiem View Point** offering panoramic valley views. Continue to witness the majestic **Seven Sisters Falls** and the spectacular **Nohkalikai Falls**, the tallest plunge waterfall in India. Later, explore the fascinating limestone formations inside the famous **Mawmai Cave**. After sightseeing, return to Shillong by evening.

Overnight stay at Shillong. (B, D)

Day 3: Shillong – Mawlynnong – Dawki – Shillong (116 Km / Approx. 3.5 Hrs One Way)

After breakfast, drive towards **Mawlynnong**, acclaimed as the “Cleanest Village in Asia.” Explore the beautiful village pathways, and surrounding greenery. Later visit the **Living Root Bridge** at Riwai and proceed to Dawki, known for the crystal-clear waters of the **Umngot River** where boats appear to float on transparent water. Enjoy the mesmerizing views of Dawki Lake and visit the Indo-Bangladesh border at **Tamabila Border**. After sightseeing, return to Shillong in the evening.

Overnight stay at Shillong. (B, D)

Day 4: Shillong – Kaziranga (252 Km / Approx. 7 Hrs)

After breakfast, check out and drive towards **Kaziranga National Park**, the UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for the one-horned rhinoceros. En route, visit the revered **Maha Mrityunjay Temple** at Nagaon, known for housing one of the tallest Shiva lingas in the world. Continue the journey through scenic Assamese countryside and tea gardens. Upon arrival at Kaziranga, check in to the hotel/resort. Evening at leisure.

Overnight stay at Kaziranga. (B, D)

Day 5: Kaziranga Sightseeing

Early morning, enjoy an exciting **Jeep Safari in Kaziranga National Park** where you may spot one-horned rhinos, wild elephants, swamp deer, wild buffaloes, and various bird species in their natural

habitat. Return to the hotel for breakfast and relaxation. In the afternoon, visit the famous **Kaziranga Orchid & Biodiversity Park** to witness the rich cultural heritage of Assam, traditional dance performances, and a wide variety of orchids and medicinal plants.

Overnight stay at Kaziranga. (B, D)

Day 6: Kaziranga – Dirang (225 Km / Approx. 7 Hrs)

After breakfast, begin your picturesque journey towards **Dirang** in Arunachal Pradesh. The route passes through beautiful mountain landscapes, rivers, and dense forests. Dirang is a peaceful Himalayan town known for its monasteries, and scenic beauty. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and relax amidst the serene surroundings.

Overnight stay at Dirang. (B, D)

Day 7: Dirang – Tawang (175 Km / Approx. 6 Hrs)

After breakfast, proceed towards Tawang via the spectacular Sela Pass situated at an altitude of 13,700 ft, offering mesmerizing snow-clad mountain views and the pristine **Sela Lake**. En route, visit the **Jaswant Garh War Memorial** dedicated to Rifleman Jaswant Singh Rawat and witness the beautiful **Jung Falls** cascading through the mountains. Upon arrival at Tawang, visit the **Tawang War Memorial** and enjoy the impressive Light & Sound Show along with the cultural performance showcasing local traditions. Check in to the hotel.

Overnight stay at Tawang. (B, D)

Day 8: Tawang Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, proceed for an adventurous excursion to **Bumla Pass** located near the **Indo-China border** (subject to permit and weather conditions). En route, visit the stunning **Madhuri Lake (Sangetsar Lake)**, famous for its surreal beauty and cinematic backdrop featuring in the famous bollywood movie Koyla. Later visit the serene **Giant Buddha Statue/Buddha Temple** offering panoramic views of Tawang town. Return to the hotel by evening.

Overnight stay at Tawang. (B, D)

Day 9: Tawang – Dirang (134 Km / Approx. 5 Hrs)

After breakfast, visit the famous **Tawang Monastery**, the second-largest monastery in the world and an important centre of Mahayana Buddhism. Later drive back towards Dirang through scenic mountain roads. Upon arrival, visit the peaceful **Dirang Monastery** and enjoy the tranquil atmosphere of the valley. Check in to the hotel.

Overnight stay at Dirang. (B, D)

Day 10: Dirang – Guwahati (377 Km / Approx. 10 Hrs)

After an early breakfast, check out and drive back to Guwahati through the beautiful landscapes of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and relax after the long journey.

Overnight stay at Guwahati. (B, D)

Day 11: Guwahati – Agartala

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Agartala. Upon arrival, proceed for sightseeing including a visit to the beautiful **Jagannath Temple**. Later witness the thrilling **Retreat Ceremony/Border Parade at the India-Bangladesh Border** (subject to operation and timings).

Overnight stay at Agartala. (B, D)

Day 12: Agartala Sightseeing

After breakfast, enjoy a full-day sightseeing tour of Agartala. Visit the magnificent **Ujjayanta Palace**, the former royal palace of the Tripura Kingdom showcasing Indo-Saracenic architecture. Later proceed to **Neer Mahal**, the beautiful lake palace built in the middle of Rudrasagar Lake by

the Maharaja of Tripura. Continue to visit the sacred **Tripura Sundari Temple**, one of the 51 Shakti Peethas in India. Return to the hotel in the evening.

Overnight stay at Agartala. (B, D)

Day 13: Agartala – Imphal

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Imphal. Upon arrival, proceed to visit the famous **Ima Keithel (Mothers' Market)**, a unique all-women-run market and one of the largest of its kind in Asia. Later enjoy the vibrant **Sangai Festival** showcasing the rich cultural heritage, dances, handicrafts, and cuisines of Manipur.

Overnight stay at Imphal. (B, D)

Day 14: Imphal Sightseeing

After breakfast, proceed for local sightseeing in Imphal. Visit the historic **Kangla Fort**, once the royal seat of the Manipur kingdom. Later drive to the breath taking **Loktak Lake**, the largest freshwater lake in Northeast India known for its unique floating islands called "Phumdis." Also visit the **INA Museum** dedicated to the Indian National Army and Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. Return to the hotel by evening.

Overnight stay at Imphal. (B, D)

Day 15: Imphal – Kohima

After breakfast, drive towards Kohima, the capital city of Nagaland known for its scenic beauty and tribal culture. Attend the grand opening ceremony of the **Hornbill Festival**, often called the "Festival of Festivals," celebrating the culture and traditions of Nagaland's tribes through music, dance, food, and performances.

Overnight stay at Kisama Village (B, D)

Day 16: Hornbill Festival

After breakfast, enjoy a full day at the **Hornbill Festival** grounds at **Kisama Heritage Village**. Experience traditional tribal dances, folk music, indigenous games, local handicrafts, Naga cuisine, and cultural exhibitions from various tribes of Nagaland. The festival offers a vibrant glimpse into the rich traditions and lifestyle of the region.

Overnight stay at Kisama Village (B, D)

Day 17: Kohima – Dimapur Airport – Mumbai

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Dimapur Airport for your onward flight to Mumbai with unforgettable memories of the enchanting Northeast India tour with Kaustubh Tours..!!
